- Watercolor paper, 140LB or heavier. Cold Pressed in pad, loose sheets or Block. At least 11X14"
- White paper towel roll
- **Watercolor paint in tubes, sets. Best quality available.** Various colors. Suggested Color list below.
- Mixing palette such as White Enamel Butcher Tray or white Plastic Palette
- Gum Arabic, small jar
- Small container rock/kosher salt
- Painters tape (Blue or Green)
- #2 Pencil
- Kneaded eraser

Carolann's favorite paint colors for Watercolor, Acrylic and Water Media. Suggested but not required. Sets can be purchased at local art stores and are acceptable.

Warm Colors

1. Sap Green
2. Cobalt Violet
3. Permanent Rose
4. Ultramarine Blue
5. Cadmium Red
6. Cadmium Yellow Medium
7. Naples Yellow
8. Burnt Sienna
9. Unbleached Titanium
10. Burnt Umber

Cool Colors

1. Pthalo Green or Viridian
2. Payne's Grey
3. Cerulean Blue or Cobalt Blue
4. Prussian Blue
5. Alizarin Crimson
6. Lemon Yellow
7. Raw Umber
8. Raw Sienna

Titanium White

I make my Black = Alizarin Crimson, Prussian Blue and a drop of Cad Yellow.
